What's New



This week, Governor Nikki Haley signed the following bills into law. Most of these bills were passed by the General Assembly during the final week of the 2013 Legislative Session.

- S. 2 - Equal Access to the Ballot Act
- S. 127- Creates the Brain Injury Leadership Council
- S. 341- The Emerson Rose Act
- S. 460- Revises responsibilities of surplus lines insurance brokers
- S. 463- Requiring background checks for bondsmen
- S. 481- Revises admissions tax exemptions
- S. 484- Revises disability determinations for the Police Officer Retirement System
- S. 551- Updates hunting seasons in Game Zone 1
- S. 562- Expands recovery options for improvements made in good faith
- S. 584- Regarding the issuance of hunting and fishing licenses
- S. 590- Creates a minimum length for Tarpon
- S. 610- Extends completion times for certain economic development projects
- H. 3184- Matches expungement eligibility to current fines and penalties
- H. 3378- Volunteer Service Personnel Appreciation Act
- H. 3451- Expands the offenses that may be cited on a Uniform Traffic Ticket
- H. 3502- Clarifies eligible transfers of assets to the Citadel Trust
- H. 3557- Increases eligibility for the Port Volume Increase tax credit
- H. 3602- Defines certain activities as theft or fraud

- H. 3632- Directs maintenance tax funding to the Workers' Compensation Commission
- H. 3735- Decouples Atlantic Black Sea Bass catch limits from federal regulations
- H. 3752- The Expanded Virtual Learning Act
- H. 3870- Updates the Firefighter Mobilization Act of 2000
- H. 3944- Reconstitutes the Murrell's Inlet - Garden City Fire District
- H. 3956- Reduces the number of rooms in the definition of "furnishing lodging"
- H. 3960- Defines employer and plan management responsibilities for MEWAs
- H. 3962- Updates voting precincts in Greenwood County
- H. 3971- The Greenville Health System
- H. 3974- Regarding information sharing and lien disposition
- H. 4192- Updates voting precincts in Berkeley County
- H. 4204- Updates voting precincts in Chester County
